Dr. Helper is also a research associate of the National Bureau of Economic Research and of the International Motor Vehicle Program. Her research focuses on the globalization of supply chains, and on how manufacturing in the United States might be revitalized.

Dr. Helper has published in journals such as American Economic Review and Sloan Management Review. She is a judge for the Automotive News PACE award for supplier innovation.

Dr. Helper has a Ph.D. in economics from Harvard University and a B.A. from Oberlin College.
